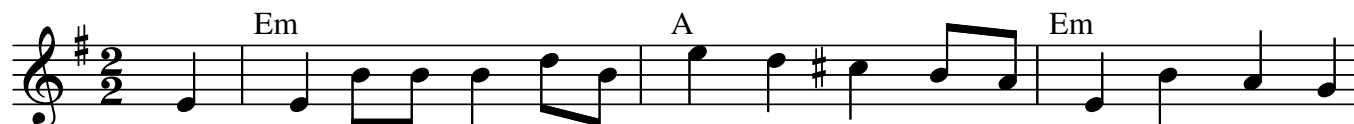


Candlemas Hymn

all. One for strength and health, and one That our feet not stum-ble and



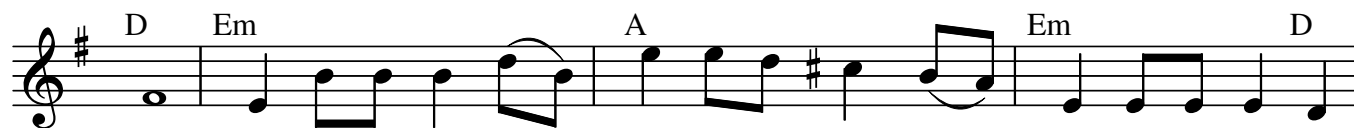
fall. One can-dle we light for o - pen ears If the Gods should call our name,

2. One can-dle we light for gifts re-ceived And one for the torch we



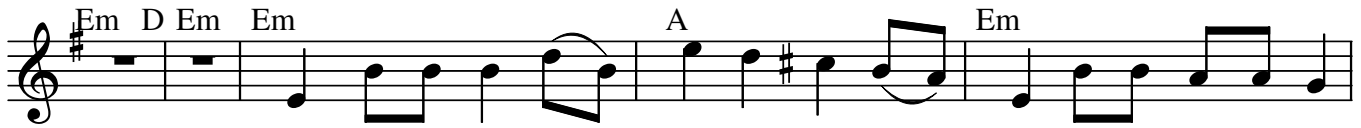
hold, One for the rain and one to con - strain And one for the win-ter's
